## Week 7: How Do I Use The Dynamic Gifts Of The Holy Spirit?

**Start talking.** Find a conversation starter for your group.

- Of the nine gifts of the Spirit, which do you desire the most?

**Start thinking.** Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- Have you ever thought "why do I read about all these supernatural things in the Bible but I don't see them much today?"

**Start sharing.** Discuss the main points from Sunday's message.

**The Gift Of Faith:** A supernatural impartation of belief and confidence for a specific situation.

- Have you ever experienced a time when something big happened and you surprisingly had faith for it? Share what happened.
- In Acts 6, Stephen is a normal guy with a small task of serving meals to widows, yet he was doing wonders and signs. What insignificant assignment does God have you doing right now?"

**The Gift Of Healing:** A supernatural ability to restore someone to divine health.

- Have you ever prayed for someone to be healed? What happened?
- Why is important we understand that God chooses who, when and how He will heal?

**The Gift Of Miracles:** A divine intervention that alters our natural circumstances.

- Have you seen or experienced a miracle before? Share.
- Why is it essential we understand that faith & obedience is our responsibility and the results are God's?

**Start praying.**

- **Focus on the presence of the Holy Spirit.** Ask God to help you see and act on the opportunities in front of you. Thank him for giving you His Holy Spirit along with the gifts.

**Start doing.**

- **Encourage your group.** To step out in faith and obedience when they are presented with an opportunity to use the gifts. Remind them that our part is to have faith & obedience but the results are God's.
