“MAN & HIS LEGACY”



Legacy is not about making a **NAME**, but making a **DIFFERENCE**.

*(Matthew 22:37-38) “**Love the Lord** your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment.”*

*(Matthew 28:19-20) “Therefore, **go** and **make disciples** of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. **Teach** these new disciples to **obey** all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age.”*

A Man’s Legacy is to **BE** a disciple and **MAKE** disciples.

WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE TO BE A DISCIPLE?

1) Commitment to **FOLLOW** Jesus.

*(Luke 14:27) “And if you do not carry your own cross and **follow me**, you cannot be my **disciple**.”*

2. Commitment to **LIVE** like Jesus.

*(Ephesians 5:1-2) **Imitate God**, therefore, in **everything you do**, because you are his dear children. Live a life filled with love, **following the example of Christ**.*

Discipleship is more about what you become than what you know.

WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE TO MAKE DISCIPLES?

1) **INVITATION**

*(Mark 1:17) And Jesus said to them, “**Come, follow me**, and I will make you become fishers of men.”*

*(John 3:22) “Then Jesus and his disciples left Jerusalem and went into the Judean countryside. Jesus **spent some time with them there**.”*

2) **IMITATION**

*(1 Corinthians 11:1) “you should **imitate me**, just as **I imitate Christ**.”*

You teach what you know; you reproduce who you are.

3) **IMPARTATION**

*(2 Timothy 2:2) “And the things that **you** have heard from **me** among many witnesses, commit these to **faithful men** who will be able to teach **others** also.”*

The goal of discipleship is not just information, but impartation.

INFORMATION	IMPARTATION
Informed mind	Transformed heart
Received through podcast, book, etc...	Received through relationships
Taught in classroom	Taught everywhere real life happens
